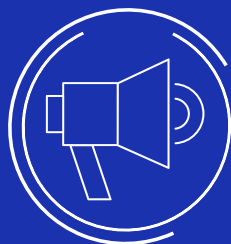

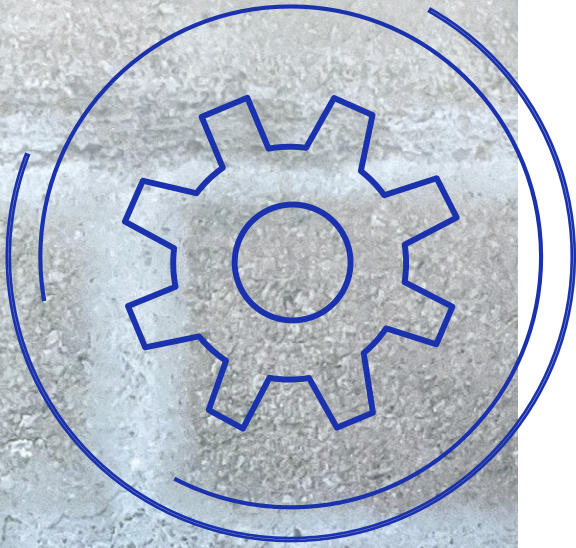


Networking & Mentorship

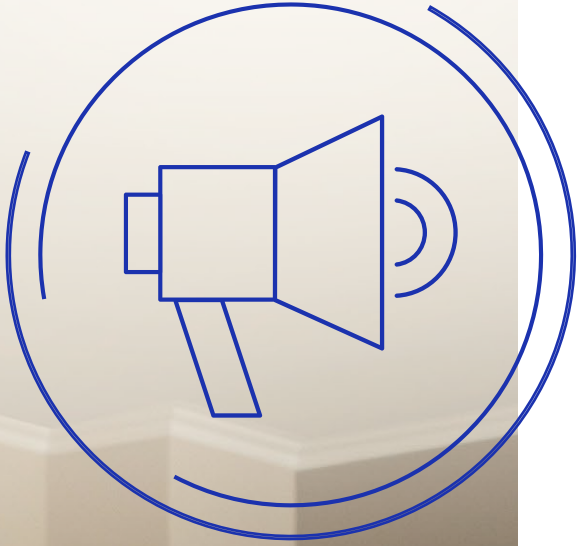
